Rules

1. The judges' decision is final.
2. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes through lack of entries or split classes if numbers warrant. .
3. Objections must be made in writing and handed to the Secretary within half an hour of the event with a deposit of £20 which will be refunded only if the objection is sustained.
4. All liability is disclaimed in respect of any loss damage or injury to competitors or their property.
5. The organisers reserve the right to substitute other judges, for those named, or to make additional appointments.
6. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any judge or official on the part of the exhibitor, groom, rider or driver of an animal will at the discretion of such official disqualify the animal for being judged, in which case the entry fees and charges will be forfeited.
7. The organisers will adhere as closely as possible to the time table, but reserve the right to put forward or back any class if it is found expedient to do so.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without specifying the reason for doing so.
9. All horses and ponies 3 years old and under must be shown by handlers 16 years and over.
10. Whilst it is normal to show only in snaffle or double bridles an exception will be made at this show and any recognised bit will be permitted however, the judge may comment or penalise, see schedule for class 11.
11. Any horse/pony thought by the organisers to be dangerous or likely to cause an accident will either have to stay in the trailer/horsebox or leave the showground.
